Becoming a Qualified SWPPP Practitioner (QSP) and/or a Qualified  
SWPPP Developer (QSD) is obtained via a specific process.

California's Construction General Permit (CGP) identifies a set of pre-  
requisite qualifications that would demonstrate the skills, knowledge and  
experience necessary to prepare and/or implement SWPPPs.

In addition, the CGP requires that individuals in these positions complete  
a State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) approved or  
sponsored training course.

Any individual may attend the Course for their own benefit.

Construction General Permit, Erosion Control, Vegetation Establishment,
